Facts and figures

First formed as a charity in 2003, The Harbour welcomes through its doors over 350 people a year who have fled war and oppression.

They come from many countries, including Sudan Eritrea, Syria, Iran and Iraq.

An average of 60 people a day come for help, advice and companionship.

Our staff of five is supported by a team of over sixty volunteers. Our annual income is just over £130,000: roughly a quarter from the local Council, a quarter from the BIG Lottery and the rest from charitable grants and donations.
